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Who we support

The PSH program is designed to provide housing opportunities to individuals who need a little extra help and support. Individuals who are equipped with the skills and necessary professional and financial support systems to better manage behavioral health-related barriers and foster successful independent living.

- Program pays up to 100% of rent directly to landlord.
- Program assists participants with budgeting and linking to payee as needed.
- Program monitors and sets up supports for participants to maintain housing.
- Program assists in mediating issues to help participants maintain housing.

- Program provides on call staff to assist participants in managing concerns and issues.
- Program seeks to build ongoing relationships with landlords to fill vacancy for program and landlord.
- Program strives for participant housing to be successful for participant and to keep in good with landlord for future referrals.
